¹ Systems and resources for Sexual and Reproductive Health (SRH), as outlined in the Minimum Initial Service Package (MISP) for Reproductive Health, that should be assessed include:

- Location of facilities that provide essential childbirth and newborn care
- Number and cadre of trained health care workers at each facility;
- Available emergency transportation system and number of vehicles;
- Location(s) of clinical care for survivors of sexual violence;
- Systems for prevention of HIV (standard precautions; safe rational blood transfusion; condom distribution);
- Systems for delivery of anti-retroviral drugs;
- Systems for delivery of contraceptive commodities
- Systems for treating sexually transmitted infections (STIs)
