MISP Readiness Assessment Tool

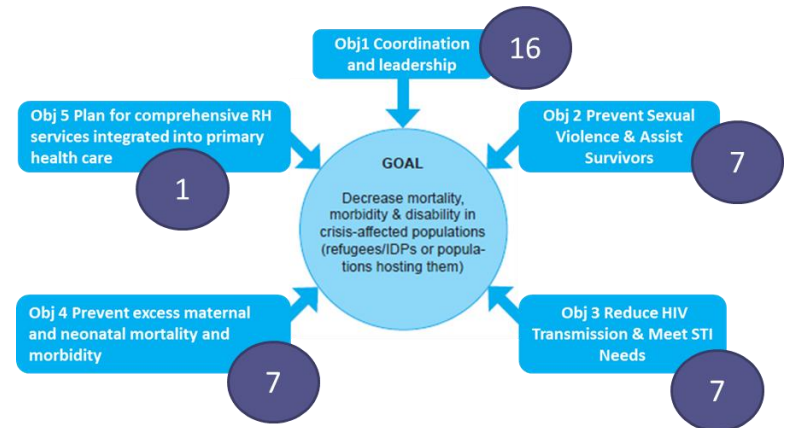
○ Assessment of national capacity to respond to SRH needs:

- Enabling Environment
- Efficient response coordination
- Integration of the MISP in emergency response plans
- Capacities and resources

Assessment of countries' readiness to provide Minimum Initial Service Package for SRH during a Humanitarian Crisis in the Eastern Europe and Central Asia Region



Report



- **38 Indicators** describing an ideal state of emergency preparedness (readiness)
- Set of questions to measure the indicators

→ National SRH actors and Disaster Risk Management actors together

The MISP Readiness Assessment helps you to:

- ✓ **Prioritize**
- ✓ **Design your action plan**
- ✓ **Monitor your progress for better preparedness**

Tool developed by the ECA Regional IAWG

- **18 countries** filled their assessment tool in 2014
- in 2014 – only **38%** had some coordination on SRH in place, in 2015 – **78%**
- More than **90** Ministries, Institutions, Organizations have been involved in the process
