Contraception within emergency response = essential, wanted, needed & possible. Access to #contraception helps ensure women & girls have the power to make autonomous decisions about their bodies & their futures.

We know that the #SRH needs of women & girls don't stop when emergencies strike—let's make #contraception an essential part of any emergency health response.

DYK: 32 million women & girls are affected by conflict and disaster. They deserve access to basic health care—including #reprohealth and #contraception.

Contraception within emergency response = essential, wanted, needed & possible. Expanding access to family planning in emergency settings moves women's lives forward, benefits their families & powers progress in the places where they live.

#SDGs and #fp2020 commitments can only be achieved when countries respond to the needs of people living in protracted crises. This includes ensuring all women & girls have access to contraception and other #SRH services.

Ensuring universal access to #familyplanning will help countries achieve nearly half of the 17 #SDGs.

Demand for contraception increases during emergencies—a time when women & girls need it most. Emergency responders, governments & development actors need to collectively scale-up access to #contraception for women & girls affected by crises.

Women & girls need access to #contraception within emergency crisis settings. #SRH services are essential, wanted, needed & possible—sustained engagement from diverse actors is required to address their #reprohealth needs & uphold their right to access #contraception.

Research shows up to 40% of women experiencing displacement across diverse settings want to avoid becoming pregnant in the next two years. #contraception within emergency response = essential, wanted, needed and possible
